Justification

The British Machine Vision Conference (BMVC) focuses mainly on machine vision, which is an area lies in the intersection of computer vision, multimedia, and AI. The request to rank the conference is to CORE A. Citation statistics of publications and the range of PC members are between the current CORE B conferences and COREA*/A conferences. The conference has been a main targeted venue of the global computer vision and AI community. BMVC is also a main venue behind the CORE A* venues for CV such as CVPR, ICCV, and ECCV, which is in a similar status for CORE A venues such as ACCV and WACV. There are concerns on the close deadlines with other CORE A*/A venues yet BMVC still attracts papers with good quality.

The Google h5 index is 75. According to Citation centiles, this is a slightly higher score than other B-ranked conferences. Median h-index of PC members is 12.00. The peer review quality of the conference is close to A*/A.

Reviewers all agree that BMVC should be ranked CORE A.
