Decision Conference to be ranked as C

Justification

The Committee considers SCAM to be a clearly credible Workshop event that attracts involvement from a range of authors, including some very well-regarded scholars, but this is offset by minimal consistent involvement of top SE researchers in the Area Leaders list. Citation centiles suggest impact falls between C and B, and the PC mainly comprises emerging rather than established researchers in the field (with a median h index of 9.5). Of the established researchers on the PC, fewer than half actively publish at the event. The Google h5 index of 13 places it below what would be typical of B venues in the software systems subfield. Considered holistically the data are neither sufficiently compelling nor consistent to justify a change in ranking at this time.
