There was some discussion as to whether this was at the borderline of A/A* due to its somewhat smaller size and its Google Scholar h5 index of 32 (where 43 is the 20th item in AI). However h5 index disadvantages smaller venues. Its ranking by h index in LiveShine is stronger than some other A* AI venues, such as ICAPS and KR. It has a committed community of regular publishers who are strong researchers. Committee consensus was it should remain as A*.
