The submission requested to retain the rank of A*, which was considered to be justified ubiquitously by the committee. IPSN has an h5 of 27 and is a small single-track conference (~25 full-length papers/year) in a relatively small research community that is a part of ACM/IEEE CPS-IoT Week. IPSN is considered to be one of the two best conferences in sensor networks with SenSys (A*) and with similar WPP, h-index, (highly-selected) acceptance rates. The submission and conference dates of IPSN and SenSys are (rotated to be~) 6 months apart, and have a largely overlapped organising and technical committees, and authors. Furthermore, IPSN has an ACM average citations of 20, which is considered to be good, which also shows that leading researchers as frequent publishers. ACM shows strong people as frequent publishers there The committee also agreed that its standing in the community warrants a rank of A* ubiquitously.
