The submission requested a new ranking at the rank of A, which was considered to be justified, especially when considering this is a specialist conference. The conference has an h5 of 31, which is reasonable for an A conference, and has strong avg citations per article which is also supported by the provided ACM data. The conference is listed as 14th in the top 20 Google Scholar conferences on HCI.

It has a typical acceptance rate of less than 25% with over 400 submissions per year, which is very selective. The General Chairs are relatively strong with h-index scores of 15-33, with similar h-index scores for the Program Chairs. The Senior PC seems to have an average h-index of 10-14. An impressive 15 of 16 of the established PC members publish in the conference, and 12 of the 19 ACM ToCHI editors. The frequent authors generally look very strong supporting the overall impression.
