The submission requested a new ranking at the rank of A*, which was considered to be justified. The conference has an h5 of 44, which is high and the conference is listed at number six in the top 20 Google Scholar conferences on HCI. It has a typical acceptance rate of less than 25% with 325-380 submissions per year, which is very selective.

The General Chairs are very strong with h-index scores of 40-75, with similar h-index scores for the Program Chairs. The Senior PC seems to have an average h-index of 10-14, but many with a higher h-index. An impressive 22 of 23 of the Senior PC publish in the conference, with many leaders in HCI always attending.

This is widely recognised in the HCI research community as a highly selective, peak venue for highly innovative and very technical research.
