Each pair of main chairs of simposia, must conform the PC members list by considering: \* For each PC member: - The last title (must be Dr or PhD) - Experience as researcher in the specif area of the corresponding simposium (google scholar, list of publications) - Faultless ethics and morals

\* For the whole list: - Balance in the participation of different genders. - Balance in the participation of all member countries of the CLEI organization. - Participation of recognized researchers from no member countries of the CLEI organization.

The Conference brings together researchers, professionals, teachers, and students in a forum to discuss topics addressed to the areas of Computer Science, Information Systems and other areas of Information Technology, as well as the direct impacts of ICT (Information and Communication Technologies). Communication) in the Society as a whole. Its objective is the exchange of ideas, experiences, and research results in the areas of interest of the community, through conferences, workshops, tutorials, contests, and panels.

CLEI is the most ancient Ibero-American conference. It has been held since 1974 without interruption, traveling on the member institutions of the Latin American Center for Computer Studies: 83 Universities and National Computing Societies from Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Ecuador, El Salvador, Spain, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay, USA, Venezuela. Next celebration in Costa Rica (2021) will be the 47th edition.

Every year, participants come from all over the world: from member institutions, from France, Italy, The Netherlands, Portugal, Germany, Australia, Argely, and many others countries, as authors, reviewers, keynotes, panelists, and attendees.

Best theoretical papers are published in Electronic Notes in Theoretical Computer Science Journal, ELSEVIER. Best papers (not theoretical) are invited to publish extended versions to CLEI Electronic Journal. In the past, best papers were also invited to present extended versions to NovÅtica, Journal of the Computer Technicians Association, Spain. All proceedings are published in IEEE Xplore. As a Conference, CLEI has participated in the elaboration of the ACM/IEEE CC 2020 curricula standard.
