This journal was reviewed by the 0806 committee in 2019 because of its mixed numeric citation indicators.

The fifty members of the editorial board have an average GS h-index of 43, and a median h-index of 42. One editorial board member could not be identified at GS.

Of the fifty, 48 board members could be located for WPP purposes. Across the 48, 31 of them had published in Transactions on Computer-Human Interactions in the last ten years since 2009, with a total of 60 papers. It was the top journal in the WPP listing, with the next one Interactions (57 papers, 20 authors), and then Human-Computer Interaction (22 papers, 18 authors).

ToCHI attained a recognition rate of 31% in the 0806 field in the 2017 survey.

Given these statistics, and the respect with which it is held in the community, ACM Transactions on Computer-Human Interactions is recommended to retain its A\* rating in the CORE journal rankings.
