That the FOR code of ICAPS be changed (back) to 0801
("Artificial Intelligence ...")

ICAPS used to be indexed by CORE as a 08 conference. See for example <http://web.archive.org/web/20081020054407/http://www.core.edu.au/> An error introduced in the first ERA process placed ICAPS in FOR code 1005 ("Communication Technologies"). My personal guess is that the clerical error comes from a confusion with ICASSP, the International Conference on Acoustics, Speech and Signal Processing <http://www.icassp2013.com>

Automated Planning and Scheduling is one of the core disciplines of Artificial Intelligence http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Automated_planning_and_scheduling. The conference itself is a merger between the Artificial Intelligence Planning Systems conference and the European Conference on Planning. The ICAPS bank account is managed by the Association for the Advancement of Artificial Intelligence (AAAI). Hopefully I don't need to say more to justify that it belongs to 0801.
