AIED was submitted as a comparator for "A" - it was also on the "must submit" list, but did not make a submission. The committee noted a range of positive indicators including h5=21, strong chair, acceptance rate not too high, on the other hand, the PC was somewhat weak (only 18 out of 106 considered established). The WPP report provided was incorrect (used the whole PC), and a corrected report was generated. This showed that AIED was the most common venue for the more established PC members (see below). The committee reached a consensus to recommend retaining "A".
