AIME was submitted as a comparator for "B". The committee noted a range of positive indicators, including (mostly) strong chairs, and a strong (and active) PC. Although the submitted report indicated $h5=34$, in fact Google Scholar has two venues named "Artificial Intelligence in Medicine" (respectively $h5=39$ and $h5=11$). The latter is the conference ($h5=11$) - the stronger one is the journal. We also noted that in 2020 AIME went annual and international. Overall, the committee considered this a clear "B".
